

Campaign Timeline – Phase One

- 23 January 2024 while 'options appraisal' is still underway (due to end January 2024)
 launch e-action to lobby <u>Board members</u> ('stakeholder communications and engagement' runs October 2023 February 2024)
- 2 February 2024 Board members will be attending a private 'information session' about the proposed options
- 23 February 2024, 9:30am Strategy & Programmes Committee Meeting
 Petition Hand-in at SPT Offices
- 15 March 2024, 9am SPT Board Meeting when 'recommended preferred option(s) from appraisal presented for approval' Rally/Action at SPT Offices
- April May 2024 public consultation on appraisal recommendations
 mass public mobilisation
- Later in 2024 (date TBC) results of the consultation reported to the SPT Board to feed into the next stages of development of the SRBS



Campaign Timeline – Phase Two

- March 2025 the SRBS Strategy & Delivery Plan should be delivered (Work Package 4)
- June 2025 the Strategic Business Case should be delivered (Work Package 5) (all dates above according to the Progress Update presented at the SPT Board Meeting in December 2023)

Then, providing SPT are progressing with franchising, these will be the next steps (according to the <u>Transport Scotland Flowchart</u>):

- Later in 2025 (est. date) Audit of 'financial implications' of the proposed franchising framework (Business Case)
- Late 2025/early 2026 (est. date) Statutory Public Consultation on proposed franchising framework mass public mobilisation
- 2026 (est. date) SPT submits proposed franchising framework to Traffic Commissioner for approval by an independent panel mass public mobilisation

Providing the franchising framework is approved:

Approx 2028/2029 – the first regulated buses for more than 42 years hit the streets of Strathclyde
